Bids were opened on June 6th with four bids being submitted, the results were as follows:

The Rehabilitation of the Stonelick Williams Corner Covered Bridge includes the removal and replacement of the roof and exterior siding, additional structural support members to improve the load capacity, deck replacement, new lighting system and security system.

Construction will start in early November of this year. The construction will take approximately six months which will allow for the timber and steel work to be done throughout the winter and temperature dependent items to be completed in the spring. We greatly appreciate the support and understanding of the public and county/township officials throughout this extensive design and construction process.
